

Dear Resident,

These are uncertain times for our community. It is devastating to see so many businesses being closed.

Brookhaven is placed in a very difficult spot, as the park has so far not been granted any relief from its mortgage payments and other recurring expenses such as utility bills, property taxes, and insurance costs. Brookhaven must balance resident needs with the park's need to remain financially solvent, pay contractors, and continue to provide services.

If your employment or income has been temporarily impacted, we would like to know about it, and invite you to apply for temporary forbearance on rent. We must balance any resident hardships with the park's need to remain financially viable, but will do our best to accommodate reasonable requests. If approved for forbearance, all late fees will be waived, and very favorable repayment options will be offered once things go back to normal. Those who do not apply and do not pay will not be given leniency on fees and repayment.
